Students will be tested on the following content: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Rhythmic dictation: 2 different rhythms will be clapped for you 3 times each by your teacher for you notate on your exam paper.- Pitch: 3 pairs of notes will be played on the piano for you by your teacher and you will need to notate whether the SECOND NOTE in each pair is either higher, lower or the same as the first note.- Notation: 4 different notes have been written on the Treble Clef and you will need to identify either the name, duration and/or pitch of each note.
