Students submit a hand built ceramic fish sculpture.
Detailed Assessment Task Description
Students make a ceramic fish using hand building and decorative techniques such as pinch pot, slab, incise, cut out and relief. The resolved sculpture will be glazed.

Outstanding (O)	A very high example of a hand built ceramic fish. Excellent use of decorative techniques including relief, incise and cut out. Competence in selecting colours. The work is highly resolved and aesthetically pleasing.	21-25
High (H)	A competent example of a hand built ceramic fish. Good use of decorative techniques and colour. The work is resolved and aesthetically pleasing.	16-20
Sound (S)	A satisfactory example of a hand built ceramic fish. Some consideration of decorative techniques and colour. The work is resolved.	11-15
Basic (B)	A limited attempt has been made to complete a hand built ceramic fish. Minimal consideration of decorative technique and colour. Unresolved.	6-10
Limited (L)	Little or no attempt has made to complete a hand built ceramic fish.	0-5
