Task Description/Overview

Oral Presentation of exchanging Meishi using Japanese greetings and gestures.

Detailed Assessment Task Description

1. Oral presentation:

Two students will exchange Meishi using appropriate Japanese greetings and gestures. Students will be chosen in a random order to exchange Meshi during week 3-4. Students must be prepared on the day it is due. Failure to present when the student's name is called will result in a mark of zero.

2. Meishi Component:

Students must have a Meishi prepared with relevant information to exchange, with their name, address, telephone number and email address written in English.
