Task Description
Students will submit a resolved graphite/mixed media shell drawing.
Detailed Assessment Task Description
Students use a shell as the subject for a still life drawing. Consideration and attention to detail, tone, texture, perspective, scale and composition should be evident.

Grade	Description	Mark Range
Outstanding (O)	Demonstrates highly developed technical accomplishment (attention to detail, tone, texture, perspective, scale and composition) in 2D form. Students successfully experiment with materials and reflect on their actions to make informed choices about their artwork.	9-10
High (H)	Demonstrates well-developed technical accomplishment (attention to detail, tone, texture, perspective, scale and composition) in 2D form. Students experiment with materials and reflect on their actions to make a resolved artwork.	7-8
Sound (S)	Demonstrates sound technical accomplishment (attention to detail, tone, texture, perspective, scale and composition) in 2D form. Some skill evident with experimentation with materials, however not consistent.	5-6
Basic (B)	Demonstrates basic technical accomplishment. Unsophisticated experimentation with materials.	3-4
