## Sports Uniform Policy

### Sports uniform for practical lessons

The wearing of uniform will be compulsory during all Physical Education and Sport related activities.

### Key Features of the Sports Uniform

- Sport Shirt – JEHS design, polo style
- Sport shorts – JEHS design
- Socks – White
- Shoes – Sports shoes
- Cap – Navy (compulsory for sport)
- Track Suit – JEHS design for cooler months (Optional)

Students in full sports uniform will be marked with a tick. Students not in full sports uniform will be marked with a cross

**N** – Note (sickness or uniform)

**a** – absent

**O** or **O** full sports uniform

**X** – for item/s (small 'h' may be added to indicate hat only missing)

Students will be allowed out of sports uniform on one occasion over two consecutive terms. Students out of uniform on a second or subsequent occasion will be placed on Sports Uniform Detention. Explained out of uniform will be permitted for brief periods where a student brings a note explaining the reason for not having correct sports uniform and another change of clothes. A student that brings a note and no change of clothes will be treated as unexplained out of sports uniform. Any prolonged periods where a student has no sports uniform; the parent/caregiver will need to consult with the Head Teacher and Deputies regarding alternative arrangements.

When a student is out of uniform on three occasions during this period of time, a uniform letter will be sent home with a warning to parent/caregiver that should the student continue to be out of uniform, an after-school detention will be issued by the Head Teacher. If a student persists in forgetting their PE uniform this will be treated in line with the schools welfare and discipline code.

Any student that has reached this level and has been issued a School Uniform “Pink Card” level will also be given an after school detention.

## **Footwear**

For occupational health and safety reasons students will be required to wear sports shoes for practical sessions. Features of these shoes include: foot support and adjustable ties (lacers or velcro). This does not include slip on or canvas shoes.

## **Jewellery**

The wearing of expensive jewellery of any type is discouraged. Students wearing any jewellery that causes a safety concern should be asked to remove the items for practical lessons.

## **Sun Protection**

The school is conscious of the need for sun protection and teachers must ensure the wearing of the school designed caps. Hats are not to be worn in classrooms or corridors. Students should also be encouraged to apply a 30+ sunscreen.

## **Water**

All students are to be encouraged to bring water bottles to all lessons. During practical lesson, this is particularly important in the summer months.
